All students have been participating in Mindfulness this term. These lessons are continuing into next term and are run each Tuesday by Head and Heart Mindfulness. As a part of this program they are offering a free parent information session to be held on Wednesday 8th May at 2:30pm in the school library. This is a wonderful opportunity to come along and learn some techniques that your children have been learning about being resilient and calm.

NAPLAN will be conducted at the school for all students in Years 3 and 5 early next term. Once again this year, we will be holding the tests online. If you would like further information regarding this testing please see me and I can talk more in depth about what it involves.

Our school is a part of CASE—Cessnock Academy of STEM Excellence. Through this partnership we are gaining access to a variety of resources and opportunities for our students to be involved. Some of these have included Green Screen technology and the Eddie Woo excursion for Year 6. Teachers have enjoyed getting to play with equipment and are learning how it can be used in the classroom for education (and fun!). Term 2 and 3 should see an increase in opportunities for all students to engage in a variety of STEM lessons, which focus on collaboration and problem solving. This will also involve a whole school 'Early Engineers' project linked to environmental awareness. Watch this space!

As most of you would be well aware there have been plenty of issues occurring with children and online activities, especially 'Momo' and Youtube. This is a great reminder for all of us to monitor our children's exposure to online content, and talk with our kids about the dangers that can present themselves in this environment.

#### PROUD PRINCIPAL MOMENT


