

TERM 4 COVID—19 GUIDELINES

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As you may be aware there are some guidelines we need to put in place. It is important we follow these as a whole school to ensure we minimise the possibility of spreading infections.

New Guidelines;

Parents/Caregivers Onsite

- That parents/caregivers are not to come onsite unless it is urgent. We ask that parents phone and inform us of any thing that is needed.
- Any parent that does come onsite must ask that they complete an external visitor sheet in the front office on arrival.
- If parents/carers know in advanced that your child needs to leave early, please pre-arrange by phoning the office.
- When arriving to pickup your child early call the office once arrived and we will meet you at the front gate with your child.

Students who are unwell

- Students who are not well are required to stay home.
- If a student is displaying cold or flu like symptoms they must be sent to the office.
- Students must be picked up by a parent/caregiver with the possibility of a COVID Test to be completed.
- On return students will need to provide us relevant medical paperwork.

COVID-19 symptoms can include:



If your child is sick, keep them at home and get them tested for COVID-19.

Protect yourself from viruses



Clean your hands with soap and water, or hand sanitiser.

Cover your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze.



Avoid close contact with anyone with cold or flu-like symptoms.
