NEW COVID—19 GUIDELINES

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As you may be aware there are some more guidelines we need to put in place. It is important we follow these as a whole school to ensure we minimise the possibility of spreading infections.

New Guidelines;

Parents/Caregivers Onsite

- That parents/caregivers are not to come onsite unless it is urgent. We ask that parents phone and inform us of any thing that is needed.
- Any parent that does come onsite must ask that they complete an external visitor sheet in the front office on arrival.

Students who are unwell

- Students who are not well are required to stay home.
- If a student is displaying cold or flu like symptoms they must be sent to the office.
- Students must be picked up by a parent/caregiver with the possibility of a COVID Test to be completed.
- On return students will need to provide us relevant medical paperwork.
